❖ **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA- ONLY FOR BISHOP CONRAD SCHOOL STUDENTS**

- This admission will be purely *based on board examination results 2020*. It has ***no connection with the provisional admission done*** on the basis of pre board results.
- It is mandatory for all to follow this admission process. Without following this admission procedure no student will be admitted in Class XI.
- Students of Bishop Conrad School will be granted admission to class XI on **FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS AS LIMITED SEATS** are available.

THE SELECTION CRITERIA IS AS FOLLOWS:

- To opt for **PCM** group with **Computer as optional**, the students should have scored a minimum of **65 marks separately in Maths and Science** in board results.
- To opt for **PCB** group with **Biotechnology as optional**, the students should have scored a minimum of **65 marks in Science** in board results.
- To opt for **Commerce with Maths as optional** the student should have scored a minimum of **65 marks in Maths** in board results.
- A pass student of BCS will be allowed to opt for **Commerce Group with Hindi or Computer as optional ACCORDING TO THE POSITION IN MERIT AND VACANT SEATS RATIO**.

❖ **Kindly Note:** Physical Education as optional subject will be given to ***50 students only***. Those who opt for PHE **should** bring their certificates of Inter-House, Inter-School competitions and any other achievement certificates in Sports/Athletics.

❖ **PROCEDURE**

The candidate is required to come with a printout of **THIS** information circular along with the internet marksheet to the school office for filling up of the Final Admission Form. The Admission formalities will be done **from July 20 to July 24, 2020 (Timings 8:30 a.m. to 11:30a.m.)**.
